SUBJECT: Approval of the 2006 STIP Augmentation Tri-County Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP)

RECOMMENDATION: that the Council approve the enclosed 2006 STIP Augmentation Tri-County Regional Transportation Improvement Program and direct staff to submit it to the CTC for adoption in the 2006 STIP Augmentation program.

BACKGROUND

RTIPs are prepared statewide by the Regional Transportation Planning Agencies, based on local prioritization of projects and the amount of funding estimated to be available in the next State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Every two years, the CCOG submits a Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) to the California Transportation Commission (CTC) for adoption and funding. In 2006, CCOG approved the 2006 RTIP. However, with the passage of Proposition 1B by the voters in November 2006, additional STIP Augmentation funds became available. This RTIP is to program the 2006 STIP Augmentation funds. This RTIP is due to Caltrans by April 2, 2007.

DISCUSSION

Staff has worked closely with our Tri-County partners and Caltrans staff to assemble the attached RTIP for submittal to the CTC. The 2006 STIP Augmentation RTIP includes no new STIP projects. It is proposed that the new funding available pay for the SR 4 Angels Camp Bypass cost increases and the SR 49 Amador Bypass Relinquishment cost increases.

CONCLUSION

The attached RTIP provides most of the essential information required by the CTC. The RTIP is being reviewed by Amador and Alpine counties and there may be some additional revisions. Staff recommends approval of the draft 2006 RTIP.
