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**SUMMARY**

The Caltrans State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) provides funding for safety and maintenance projects on State Highways. The No. 1 SHOPP project in Calaveras County is to improve the intersection of State Route (SR) 4 and Pool Station. During a project development team meeting (PDT) meeting at Caltrans District 10, Caltrans staff has decided to pursue a complete intersection improvement project.

**DISCUSSION**

During October 2006, Caltrans District 10 held a PDT meeting regarding the SR 4 Pool Station project. It was determined during this PDT meeting that the design for the intersection will be a full intersection design and reconstruction, not just a left turn pocket as previously discussed. The proposed new intersection is being adjusted to the south and west to minimize impacts to adjacent wetland area. During the next PDT meeting, after the location of the intersection is finalized, a schedule will be developed regarding environmental clearance, right of way acquisition and construction.

The new Caltrans Project Manager for this project is IO Aquva.
